



New School Photo Scavenger Hunt

This activity is designed to be an interactive, fun exercise for you and your child. The idea is to take some time together to familiarize yourselves with the new school and make personal connections with the adults they will see throughout the year. Follow each prompt below and capture a photo of your child completing the challenge. When meeting new people, consider leading the way by introducing yourself first. Your confident example gives your child a template they can make their own.

1

How many teachers do you have this year? If you can, introduce yourself and take a picture with each one.

2

Can you find your locker or designated storage space? Take a picture of it – bonus points if you can open it on the first try!

Can you find the front office staff? Introduce yourself and ask how to find out about clubs, activities, or sports you may want to join. Then take a picture.

4

Who is your school's Principal and Vice Principal? Introduce yourself, then snap a photo together.

5

Who is your school counselor, school nurse, or student support specialist? Introduce yourself, then take a picture.

6

What is the school mascot? Take a picture with the statue, symbol, or actual mascot.

7

Does your school have a place where they post announcements or upcoming events? Take a picture of it.

Can you find the school library? If you can, introduce yourself to the librarian or media specialist and take a picture with them.

9

Does your school have a safety officer or security staff member? If you can, introduce yourself, then take a picture with them.

10

Can you find the main entrance, the nurse's office, and the front office without asking for directions? Take a picture at each one.

Once you've completed the hunt, consider sending a brief thank-you email or message through the school's communication platform to the teachers and staff you and your child met. A little proactive outreach goes a long way in keeping communication open all year long.
